C2C, Suffolk's Children in Care Council and the Corporate Parenting Board launched Suffolk's new Promise to looked after children and care leavers at the Celebration of Achievement Awards on Friday 30th October, with a 'cutting of the ribbon' ceremony. The set of promises are made by Children & Young People's services to their looked after children, setting out the standards for their care and outlining what support children can expect to receive. C2C have worked over the past year, together with members of the Corporate Parenting Board to consult with children & young people, carers and staff to find out what they felt was important and should be included in the Promise. The new look Promise has different versions for different age groups and abilities and will form an integral part of the process around planning and reviewing every child's care. We will help you see your family, friends and other people who are important to you. If there are people you can't see we will explain why.

You will have a social worker and you will know their name. They will give you their blue contact card so you know how to call them and who else to call when they are not at work.

We will listen to you and talk to you about all the important things in your life.

We will make a plan with you about how best to look after you.

We will help you to do the things that you like and be the best you can be.

If you have any problems or worries you can talk to your carer or social worker and they will work hard to sort them out with you.



We will help you to do your very best at school.

We will help you to be as healthy, well and happy as you can be.

We will only tell people things about you if they need to know them to look after you properly.
